Port of Kennewick Commission to Receive Vista Field Presentation *Meeting Venue Changed to Accommodate Stakeholders*

Kennewick, Wash. — Mr. Stephen DiJulio, attorney with the law firm Foster Pepper, will be in town April 14, 2009 to discuss issues related to Vista Field and the process required for any action involving expansion or closure of airport operations.
