Gate Update

For enhanced marina security, the port will be moving gate access a few feet back onto the dock from the current locations. New gates and frames will be fabricated of a lighter weight material to allow for door closers and better door latching.

The gates will be an improvement but will not replace the watchful eye of all marina tenants and the diligent practice of personal security.



- Report suspicious behavior to the port by calling 586-1186.
- Do not prop the gate open to give friends or family free access to the dock.
- Lock up all valuables or take them home.
- Do not loan out your gate access card.

Port staff will begin bidding this project in March.

Continued Commitment to Safety

The port continues to employ Washington Executive Protection for twice nightly patrols of Clover Island and Clover Island Marina. Security officers wear black shirts and black pants with identification clearly visible.

Vandalism in the Public Restrooms

During the winter months, the public restrooms on Clover Island have been the target of repeated vandalism causing thousands of dollars worth of damage to public property. The port operations team will be installing programmable door handles that will automatically lock at random times in the evening and unlock in the morning. Clover Island Marina tenants will continue to have 24 hour access to the restrooms through the use of a tenant-only code which can be obtained by calling Kandy at 586-1186. This code may change from time to time. Until the handles are installed the public restrooms will be manually locked at night.
