DOCK INSPECTIONS

Your marina team would like to extend a big thank you to all marina tenants for keeping the walkways and piers free of personal items. The docks are looking better and better all of the time!

In the interest of safety, emergency response and good housekeeping, it is important to stow personal items on your boat or take home when not in use.



REGISTRATION RENEWALS—IT'S THE LAW DUE EVERY YEAR

The Washington State Department of Revenue requires marinas to maintain copies of registrations for all boats in moorage. Please remember to bring a copy of your current boat registration to the marina office or leave it in the night drop box, located on the south side of the building (facing the marina). *We are missing several registrations. If you haven't taken care of this yet, please make it a priority.*

PEST CONTROL

Four times each year the Port has an outside service company spray the docks, dock boxes, and pedestals for spiders.

The next application will be around August 25th.



In an effort to extend the effectiveness of the application, please clean your boat of any spiders and spider webs. If it has been awhile since you sprayed off your boat now may be the time.
