## Missing Something?

Many thanks to all of the tenants that cleared personal items from the dock as requested in the October 2015 newsletter. The Port's moorage agreement is very clear that no items are to be stored on the dock (including personal effects that have been secured to the steel columns). As per the agreement:

### Item 7, Care of Moorage Space, Maintenance:

**UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES, NOR AT ANY TIME, MAY OWNER CHANGE, MODIFY, OR ALTER THE MOORAGE SPACE OR ANY OTHER PORTION OF THE DOCK. OWNER SHALL NOT INSTALL OR PLACE ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY, DINGHIES, EQUIPMENT, BOXES, OR LOCKERS OF ANY TYPE ON ANY PORTION OF THE DOCK OR WALKWAYS.**

*All items left on the dock or wrapped to a post were removed in January and will be disposed of if not claimed by their owners prior to **February 29, 2016**.*

New launch facilities are coming along at the Clover Island public boat ramp. The new public restrooms are complete and construction of the new launch ramps are in progress. Once the ramps are completed, a finish layer of asphalt will go down and the site will be open to the public.
