The Port of Kennewick has contracted Lakeland Restoration Services to perform an herbicide treatment for invasive/nuisance aquatic plants in the Clover Island Basin. <u>Treatment will occur</u> on or after October 10, 2024.

Products planned for aquatic use: Aquathol K, Flumigard SC, and Tribune

The following precautions are to be followed, especially for those that may be sensitive to herbicides: (if water restrictions apply to you, your dock/shoreline will be posted with a sign listing restrictions no more than 48 hours prior to treatment)

Drinking Water Restrictions: Please do not drink marina water for 3 days after treatment **Irrigation Restrictions Turf/Landscape Ornamentals**: Please do not use water from the treatment area to irrigate for 3 days after treatment.

Irrigation Restrictions Food Crops and Production Ornamentals: Please do not use water from the treatment area to irrigate for 5 days after treatment.

Livestock/Domestic Animal Consumption Restrictions: Please do not water livestock or domestic animals for 1 day following treatment.

Swimming: Please do not swim during treatment or for 1 day following treatment.

There is NO restriction for fishing or other recreational activities.

This application will involve the use of airboats. Please do not approach the airboat while it is operating and avoid the large fan on the back which produces loud noise and gusts of wind.
